CDC Sponsorship Opportunities**

**Major Career Development Sponsors (\$5,000):**

- Verbal acknowledgement as Major Sponsor during Opening Ceremonies.

**Sponsorship of Student Competitive Events (\$2,500 per event):**

*Events include: Communications, Decision Making, Imagination Station, Employment Interview, Group Challenge, Public Speaking, Extemporaneous Speaking and Team Challenge.*

- Allows students to compete in a variety of creative activities to showcase the skills and knowledge they have gained through the JMG program. Sponsorship supports the cost of facility rentals and student materials.
- Sponsor will receive acknowledgement for each event sponsored through high-quality, visible, and attractive signage displayed outside/inside all rooms hosting the event(s).
- All sponsors are invited to be a featured “judge” of the sponsored event.
- All sponsors will receive 2 complimentary meal tickets to the event lunch.
- Sponsorship materials, such as company literature, employment applications, etc., can be placed on display tables within the rooms of each sponsored event.
- All event sponsors will be individually listed in the CDC program.

### **Sponsorship of Student Tables (\$500 per table):**

- Allows eight students to participate in Career Development Conference(CDC), supporting the costs of travel expenses, meals, and awards given to students
- Sponsors will receive acknowledgement for each table sponsored through high-quality, visible, and attractive table signs.
- A seat will be reserved for a sponsor at the table, and sponsors are encouraged to attend at least the lunch portion of the day to meet and interact with students.
- All table sponsors will be individually listed in the CDC program.
- All table sponsors will be generally recognized and celebrated during the lunch portion of the event.

### **Career Expo Employer Exhibits (\$500 per exhibit):**

- Nearly 500 graduating seniors from throughout Maine who have learned the skills to be job-ready will be visiting employer booths to discuss career opportunities.
- Students are participating in a competitive event, requiring them to visit each exhibitor to qualify to win.
- Each exhibitor is provided with a 6-foot draped table; 3-sided, draped separation between exhibitors.
- All exhibitors will be individually listed in the CDC program.
- All exhibitors will receive 1 (one) complimentary meal ticket to the event lunch.
- Additional lunches are \$12.50 per person.
