" People pitch in and they sponsor kids to come to this camp who otherwise would not ever have the opportunity to go to camp," said Mosher.

" They do a lot of good for a lot of people," said Ryan Simpson, a sophomore at Brewer High School.

" It's just amazing to be out here helping," added Macy Karl, a sophomore at Brewer High School.

The Brewer High School students also donated \$600 to Camp CaPella. Thanks to that money, they're sending one of their classmates to the camp this summer.
